Iconic landmarks in Paris will be transformed into temporary sporting venues. All materials will be reused or recycled.

## EIFFEL TOWER

Most iconic - beach volleyball.

## LA CONCORDE

The urban park - including skateboarding and breaking.

Existing venues have been renovated and modernised to be more sustainable.

## ROLAND GARROS

The legendary - tennis and boxing.

## STADE DE FRANCE

The largest - athletics and rugby sevens.
