

Special 2025: Allianz Trade Award



In 2025, Allianz Trade is joining the Allianz Climate Risk Award, expanding the scope with a new category to include research on the relation of Climate Change and Extreme Weather Events with Global Trade. Examples for applicable research are better predictions of extreme weather events on trade routes, the overall resilience of trade networks to climate-related disruptions, or interdisciplinary collaboration between climate science and trade economics.
